## **Project Highlights**


#### March 2017


- 1.3.2017 A user experience survey has been carried out to obtain feedback from users. There are 107 responses as of 28 February 2017. An initial review was carried out.
- 10.3.2017 A website has been developed for the project and centre (vrbd.hsmc.edu.hk). Activities, news and latest VR and AR development will be shared in the site (Figure 1).
- 16.3.2017 A Launching Ceremony of three Research Centres, including Virtual Reality Centre, in the Hang Seng Management College was carried out (Figure 2).
